2018 QUEEN GENEVIEVE PAGEANT RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Entrant must agree to abide by all rules & regulations.
2. Entrants must attend an orientation/photo shoot on the Valley Gem boat ride to acquire your schedules for the festival. Unless prior permission is given by the Queen's Committee to miss, this is MANDATORY!
3. Entrant must be at least 17 yrs. old (a graduating senior) & no older than 22 years & attending or planning to attend college with the college minimum of full time.
4. Entrants must be enrolling or enrolled in an accredited institution for the year 2018-2019 or the scholarship & title will be forfeited to the 1st place runner-up. We stipulate that the money and title will be forfeited to the 1st place runner-up in that event. Scholarship money will be directly sent to the college & available winter quarter/semester.
5. Entrant will need to provide interview attire consisting of a suit as well as an evening gown for on-stage modeling.
6. Entrant must agree to be in Marietta, Ohio & available for all event throughout the entire festival (Sept. 7, 8, 9, 2018). Winner must also be available for the Marietta Christmas parade 2018 and in 2019, the ORSF 5K run, the Valley Gem boat ride, Captain's dinner & the 2019 ORSF.
7. Entrant agrees & understand that if chosen as Queen Genevieve, any other conflicting title needs must be forfeited.
8. All entrants must participate in all phases of the competition in order to win the title.
9. Complete & final authority for the pageant rests with the ORSF Queen's Committee. Exceptions to any rule are at the discretion of that committee.
10. Entry fee is non-refundable.
11. Entrant must certify that she is not & has never been married nor had a marriage annulled; is not now pregnant nor has given birth to a child.
12. All decisions of the judges are final.
13. There will be no consumption and or possession of alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, or tobacco products, regardless of age, while appearing on behalf of the ORSF.
14. Appropriate clothing should be worn at all times while appearing on behalf of the ORSF.
15. One female friend or family member will be permitted in the dressing room area.
16. There will be not charge for guests at the Queen Genevieve pageant.

I represent that I have not & will not engage in any activities which would bring myself, the title of Queen Genevieve, the ORSF, the Queen's Committee into dispute, ridicule or contempt to include any types of use of illegal drugs, any other illegal behavior or activity, professional or amateur, nude or semi-nude photographs, or video tapes (to include social media), prostitution, any felony conviction, probation or misdemeanor involving moral turpitude (conduct that is considered contrary to community standards of justice, honesty or good morals).
